**We, the participants, of the 3rd International Symposium on International Development and Peace through Sport, held on 12th December 2015 in Tokyo, Japan, pledge to undertake the following:**

### **EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT**

- To encourage more research on the experiences of girls and women in SDP
- To pay more attention to including disability in SDP programmes
- To ensure the full participation of local beneficiaries
- To ensure that SDP actors also involve all national sport stakeholders like the Ministries of Education and Sport, NOCs etc. in order to influence sport policies
- To take into consideration local traditional sports, PE, and other sports that may be better adapted for SDP programmes
- To use the Olympics to showcase positive social change through sport, for. Ex. host a Homeless World Cup before the 2020 Olympics in Tokyo

### **PEACEBUILDING AND DISASTER RESPONSE**

#### **To use sport not to isolate people affected by human and natural disasters**

- Utilising sport as a tool of intervention for trauma healing and psychosocial support.
