【Points to note regarding health condition】

1. If you have symptoms of the common cold such as fever, cough, sore throat, headache, or fatigue on the day of the examination, please consider forgoing the examination this time. If you test positive for infectious disease etc., please make a decision such as entering the examination venue based on the standard recuperation period indicated by physicians.
2. If you have symptoms of the common cold, please wear a mask on the day of the examination.
3. Those who show symptoms of the common cold, such as repeated coughing, may be asked to move to a different seat or testing room.

Take exit 1 of the station, the venue is located 3 minutes away on foot.

2. Examination Instructions

(1) Please be sure to bring your admission ticket for the examination. If you forget to bring it, come to the examination office (Room 432).

(2) Please bring a form of identification (such as a Residence Card, student ID, driver's license, My Number Card, or passport—any document with a photo). In addition to your Reference Card, you may be

asked to present this ID for identity verification purposes.

(3) Be seated at the designated desk by the meeting time. Switch off your cellphone, smartphone, and any wearable devices such as smartwatches, and put them in your bag for the duration of the examination. You are not allowed to use them for checking the time. There is no clock in the examination room. All devices with communication capabilities, such as wristwatch-style smartwatches and glasses-style smart glasses, must also be placed inside your bag unless they are required for the examination. If any such device is found outside your bag during the examination, it may be regarded as an instance of academic misconduct, even if it has not been used.

(4) If you are late by 30 minutes or more, you will not be allowed to take the examination. However, if you are late due to circumstances beyond your control, such as running into an accident, or a public transportation delay, come to the examination office.

(5) Pay attention to the weather conditions on examination day and try to arrive at the venue well in advance.

(6) At the beginning of the oral examination, you will be asked to present your research plan in eight minutes. Applicants are expected to present using presentation software such as Microsoft PowerPoint. Please bring your computer to connect the projector. It is not necessary but if an applicant deems needed, the printed slides can be distributed. We are not responsible for any technical problems regarding your computer.

(7) If you are found interfering with the examination in any way, disrupting proceedings, or cheating during the examination, you will be asked to leave the examination room immediately and disallowed from taking the examination.

3. Other miscellaneous information

(1) Please make your own hotel reservation as we cannot assist you with accommodation.

(2) Since the venue does not have a parking lot, we recommend you use public transportation.

(3) You are not allowed to inspect the examination room beforehand.
